



Drop-off

- Drive up to the main entrance of the Science Center and a Camp staff member will meet you at your car starting at:
 - 7:30 AM (Before Care) - additional fee and pre registration required
 - 8:20 AM (Camp only)
- Verify the Contact Information and who will pick up your child for that day
- Have your child wait in the car until the staff member can escort your child into the building

Pick-up

Pick up for campers NOT registered for After Care:

- Pick up will begin at 3:30 PM
- Drive up to the main entrance of the Science Center, wait for a Camp staff member to come to your car. Do not exit your vehicle. Please be patient and wait in the car line.
- For your child's safety, be prepared to show identification and initial the pick up form.
- After 3:45 PM your child will be moved into After Care, and you will be responsible for the After Care payment (\$50).

Pick up for campers registered for After Care:

- Enter Science Center Parking Garage (between Science Center and Brown's Stadium)
- Take a ticket, park, and come inside the Science Center (30 minutes free parking)
- Use the elevator or escalator to go up to Level 1 of the Science Center
- Check in at the Information Desk and they will be able to direct you to the After Care location for that day
- Be prepared to show the Camp staff your identification and sign the pick up form
- After GLSC closure at 5:00pm, parents may park in the front circle pick up/drop off area and pick up their child in the main lobby of the museum.
- If you have not picked up your child by 5:30 PM, a Camp staff member will stay with your child until your arrival. You will be billed the After Care price (\$50) for every 15 minutes after 5:30 PM.

Things to Bring

- Backpack & Water bottle
- Pencils/Pen
- Notebook or Journal
- Snack (one that doesn't have to be refrigerated)
- Lunch (if you did not pre-pay for a boxed lunch)

Things to Leave

- Cell phones
- MP3 players and Portable Game Systems
- Gum and Candy
- Shoes with wheels in them

Frequently Asked Questions

What type of snack should my child bring?

You may pack fruit, bag of chips, cookies, juice box, etc. but we will not be able to refrigerate the items during the day. **Although there are vending machines on site and a cafe, campers will not have access to them during the camp day.**

What should we do if we are running late to drop-off or pick-up?

If you are running a few minutes late, please call the Camps and Classes phone line at **(216) 696-5113** and leave a message. This phone will be checked regularly and phone calls will be returned if necessary. Campers arriving more than 45 minutes late will not be allowed to participate in the day's program unless prior arrangements have been made.

How will I know what my child is doing throughout the day?

Your camper will bring home a parent letter created by the Summer Science Day Camp staff that contains highlights of your camper's day.

Who will be supervising my child?

Camps are taught by certified teachers and science professionals. College-aged staff working towards a degree in education, science, technology, or a related field assist the camp instructors. Classroom aides, mature high school students, also help with simple projects in the classroom.

What if my child takes medication during the day?

We recommend that your child not bring medication, prescription or over-the-counter, to their summer camp. Please speak with your physician to determine if any medication can be taken prior to or after the camp day. If this can not occur due to the nature of the medication, (asthma inhaler, allergy medication, etc.) please be sure to indicate this on the medical form. Medicine should be kept in original prescription container, placed in a ziplock bag, and labeled with your camper's name, camp attending, and time medication is to be distributed.

Can my child bring a cell phone or iPod to camp?

We ask that you **DO NOT** allow your child to bring cell phones and electronic devices to the Science Center. These items can be very distracting during workshops and activity times. If brought to camp it will be taken away until the end of the day. Please remember, the Science Center is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Who do I contact in case of emergency?

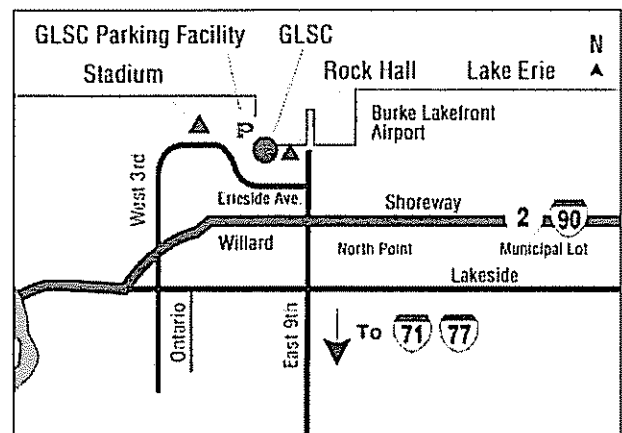
