



## Drop-off

- Once you've arrived at the Main Entrance drop-off location, look for a GLSC Camp Staff member to help direct you through the drop-off process
- A GLSC Camp Staff member will meet you at your car starting at:
  - 8:15-8:30 AM for Shuttle drop-off to Butler Campus—Pre-Registration Required
  - 8:45-9:00 AM for Drop-off at Lyman Campus
- Verify the Contact Information and who will pick up your child for that day
- Have your child wait in the car until the staff member can escort your child from the car

## Pick-up

### Pick up for campers NOT registered for After Care:

- Once you've arrived at Main Entrance for pick-up, look for a GLSC Camp Staff member to help direct you through the pick-up process
- A GLSC Camp Staff member will meet you at your car starting at:
  - 4:00-4:15 PM for Pick-up at Lyman Campus
  - 4:20-4:35 PM for Shuttle pick-up for those campers returning from the Butler Campus
- Wait for a Camp Staff member to come to your car
- Be prepared to show identification and initial the pick up form
- After 4:15 PM your child will be moved into After Care, and you will be responsible for the After Care payment (\$40).

### Pick Up For Campers REGISTERED for After Care:

4:20-5:30 PM for After Care at Lyman Campus - Main Entrance

- Please park in the circle of the main entrance to the Lyman Campus
- Once you enter the building report to the greeter who will direct you to the after care location

## Things to Bring

- Backpack & Water bottle
- Sunscreen
- Pencils/Pen
- Notebook or Journal
- Lunch & Snack (that doesn't need to be refrigerated)
- Clothing appropriate for the ALL weather (i.e. raincoat, boots, hat, jacket, etc)

- CD players, MP3 players, iPods, Game Systems
- Gum and Candy
- Shoes with wheels in them

# Frequently Asked Questions

## **What type of snack should my child bring?**

You may pack fruit, bag of chips, cookies, juice box, etc. but we will not be able to refrigerate the items during the day.

## **What should we do if we are running late to drop-off or pick-up?**

Since our days are short and time is of the essence, we ask that you arrive promptly each day. If you are running a few minutes late, then please give the Camps and Classes phone line a call at (216) 696-5113 and leave a message. This phone will be checked regularly and phone calls will be returned if necessary. Children arriving more than 45 minutes late will not be allowed to participate in the day's program unless prior arrangements have been made.

## **How will I know what my child is doing throughout the day?**

Your camper will bring home a parent letter created by the Summer Science Day Camp staff that contains highlights of your camper's day.

## **Who will be supervising my child?**

Camps are taught by certified teachers and science professionals. College-aged staff working towards a degree in education, science, technology, or a related field assist the camp instructors. Classroom aides, mature high school students, also help with simple projects in the classroom.

## **Will my child have a chance to experience the Great Lakes Science Center?**

Yes! Thursday is our field trip day to the Great Lakes Science Center. Campers travel on a bus with their instructors to the Science Center. Campers experience live science demonstrations, exploration of the 400 exhibits, and view an OMNIMAX film. Campers eat lunch at the Science Center and return by bus to Butler Campus around 3:30pm. Pick-up and drop-off procedures are not affected.

## **Can my child bring a cell phone or iPod to camp?**

We ask that you DO NOT allow your child to bring cell phones and electronic devices to Summer Camp. These items can be very distracting during workshops and activity times. If brought to camp it will be taken away until the end of the day. Please remember, the Great Lakes Science Center and Laurel School are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

## **Who do I contact in case of emergency?**

In case of an emergency or urgent message that needs to be shared with your camper, please contact the Camps and Classes phone line at (216) 696-5113. Please leave a message and we will return your phone call as soon as possible.

## **Where is Laurel School Lyman Campus located?**

## **What if my child takes medication during the day?**

We recommend that your child not bring medication, prescription or over-the-counter, to their summer camp. Please speak with your physician to determine if any medication can be taken prior to or after the camp day. If this can not occur due to the nature of the medication, (asthma inhaler, allergy medication, etc.) please be sure to indicate this on the medical form. Medicine should be kept in original prescription container, placed in a ziplock bag, and labeled with your camper's name, camp attending, and time medication is to be distributed.
